


ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

- 1) The applicant must not be a Japanese citizen.
- 2) The applicant's first language or mother tongue must not be Japanese. The applicant must be a Singapore Citizen, PR or student pass holder.
- 3) The applicant must not have stayed in Japan for an extended period of time (excluding stay in Japan before primary school):
 - Open category: not more than **36** months
 - All other categories: not more than **12** months
- 4) Those who have previously won first place in any category in this contest are not eligible to enter the contest in the same category.
- 5) Applicants under the age of 18 must obtain their parent or guardian's signed consent. No age limit for Open category.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1) Write an original script for a 4 minute (Secondary category) or 5 minute (all other categories) speech on a topic of your choice. Name your script file "Category_Name" (e.g. "Secondary_Elaine Lee")
- 2) Go to: https://form.jotform.com/jasjsc/2024 or scan the QR code to fill in the application form.
- 3) Complete the online application and submit your speech script and an audio recording of your speech no later than 09 June.
- 4) Those below 18 years old are required to upload signed consent by a parent or guardian.



- **POINTS TO NOTE** 1) You cannot submit a script that has been presented in public before. The Japanese Speech Contest Committee reserves the right to request amendments to any speech that is deemed to be of a sensitive nature.
- Free tuition (subject to availability) will be provided to finalists if requested during application.
- 3) Late applications will not be accepted. Only applications submitted via the online form above will be accepted.
- 4) The Committee reserves the right to reject any applicant found to have not met the eligibility and application requirements.
